- 1) IDENTIFYING INFORMATION and
- 2) AN ABSTRACT

Abstracts (250 word maximum) are required by March 1, 2001. See abstract guidelines below. Notification of acceptance will be mailed by April 2, 2001. If accepted, abstracts will be posted on the Symposium web site. An abstract booklet will be given to each registrant at the beginning of the Symposium.

1) IDENTIFYING INFORMATION (may be email message, word processor or paper)

- ▶ Title of Presentation
- ▶ Primary Author's name, organization, address, phone, fax and email
- ▶ Corresponding Author's name, organization, address, phone, fax and email
- ▶ Presenting Author's name, organization, address, phone, fax and email
- ▶ Each Additional Author's name, organization, address, phone, fax and email
- ▶ Recruited Presentation (if it was recruited): Name of person who recruited it and/or session it was recruited for.

2) ABSTRACT

- ▶ Acrobat.pdf (without security password) is preferred
 - ▶ If Acrobat.pdf is not an option, Word or Word Perfect can be used.
 - ▶ If an electronic version of your abstract is not possible, you may submit a paper copy.
- ▶ Formatting Instructions
 - ▶ 8.5" x 11" for page size
 - ▶ Margins – all margins on all pages are 1 inch
 - ▶ Font – Arial (or Helvetica)
 - ▶ No page numbers
 - ▶ Title - **20 point bold**

- ▶ Authors – **14 point bold**
 - ➔ Primary author first
 - ➔ Other authors
 - ➔ Underline presenting author
 - ➔ Use ^{superscripts} to identify organization/address
- ▶ Organizations – 12 point – appropriate superscript number followed by name/ address of organization
- ▶ Keywords – 12 point
- ▶ Abstract – 12 point – 250 word maximum

SYMPOSIUM PAPERS

Full papers must be received by August 1, 2001 to be included in the Proceedings and Papers volume of the 2001 International Ash Utilization Symposium. Papers should conform to the following guidelines:

- ▶ Adobe Acrobat.pdf (without security password) is preferred
 - = If Acrobat.pdf is not an option, word or WordPerfect can be used.
 - = If an electronic version is not possible, then a paper copy is acceptable.

- ▶ Page Formatting
 - = Same as Abstract requirements described above
 - = No page numbers

- ▶ References
 - = Cited in body text by superscript numerals that run consecutively
 - = References listed in numerical order on the last page
 - = Each author last name first followed by initials, journal title in italic type, publication year, volume number in bold type, page numbers.

ABSTRACT

This is the body of your abstract. It should be 8.5" x 11" page size. Lines are single spaced. The margins are 1" on top, bottom and sides. The title should have initial capital letters and should be centered. The author(s)/affiliation(s) should follow as above with name of presenter underlined. Please do not use right justification or full justification. Please do not exceed 250 word limit.
